


Parking: There will be a park and ride system in place as parking at venue is limited.

HOW TO FIND US...

...from the Cornwall Direction

Follow the A38 towards Marsh Mills roundabout. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto the B3416 towards Plympton. Keep in the right-hand lane, continue through two sets of traffic lights and then turn right into filter lane up Cott Hill, continue to the top. Turn right into Merafield Road. Continue on this road passing over the A38. Turn next right opposite the cemetery towards Wixenford. Follow the lane to the end, you are here!



...from the Exeter Direction

Follow the A38 towards Plymouth. Nearing Marsh Mills roundabout follow the signs to Plymouth City Centre. Keep right towards the roundabout. Take the third exit off of the roundabout towards Plympton, B3416. Keep in the right-hand lane, continue through two sets of traffic lights and then turn right into filter lane up Cott Hill, continue to the top. Turn right into Merafield Road. Continue on this road passing over the A38. Turn next right opposite the cemetery towards Wixenford. Follow the lane to the end, you are here!
